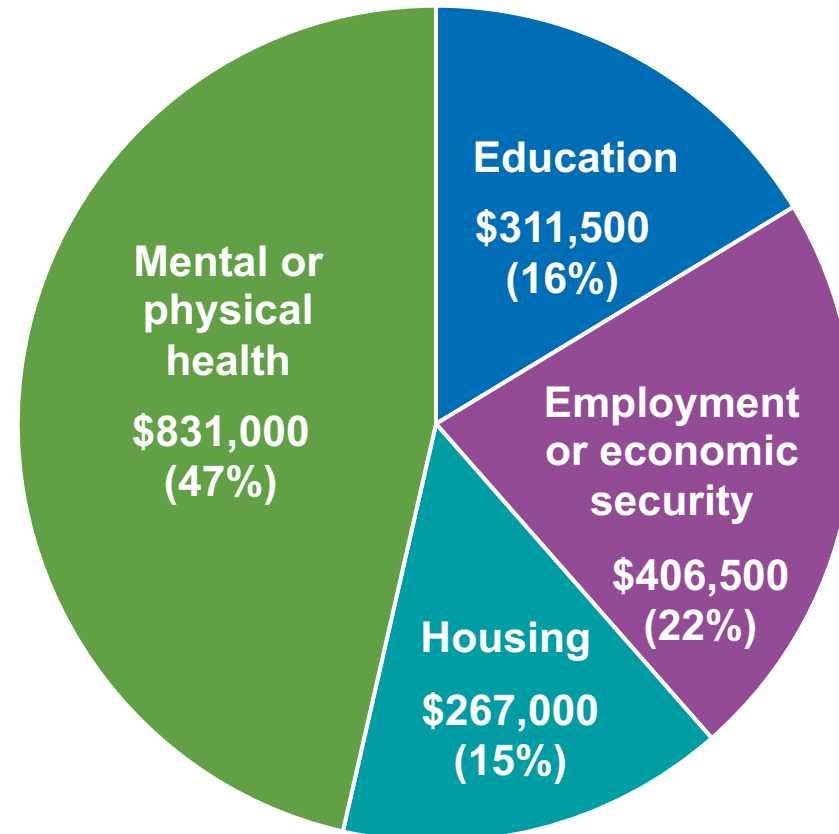

# Funded Impact Areas

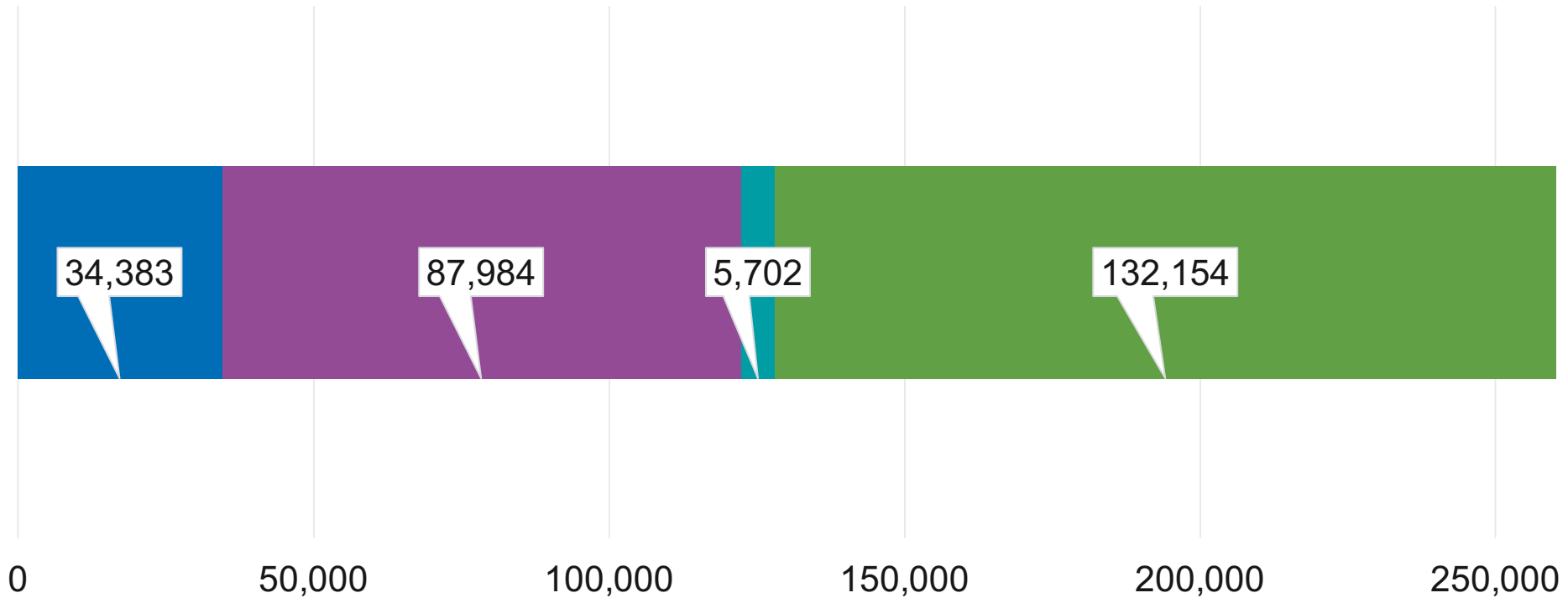
## Grants by Funded Impact Areas

Total = 260,223 Clients

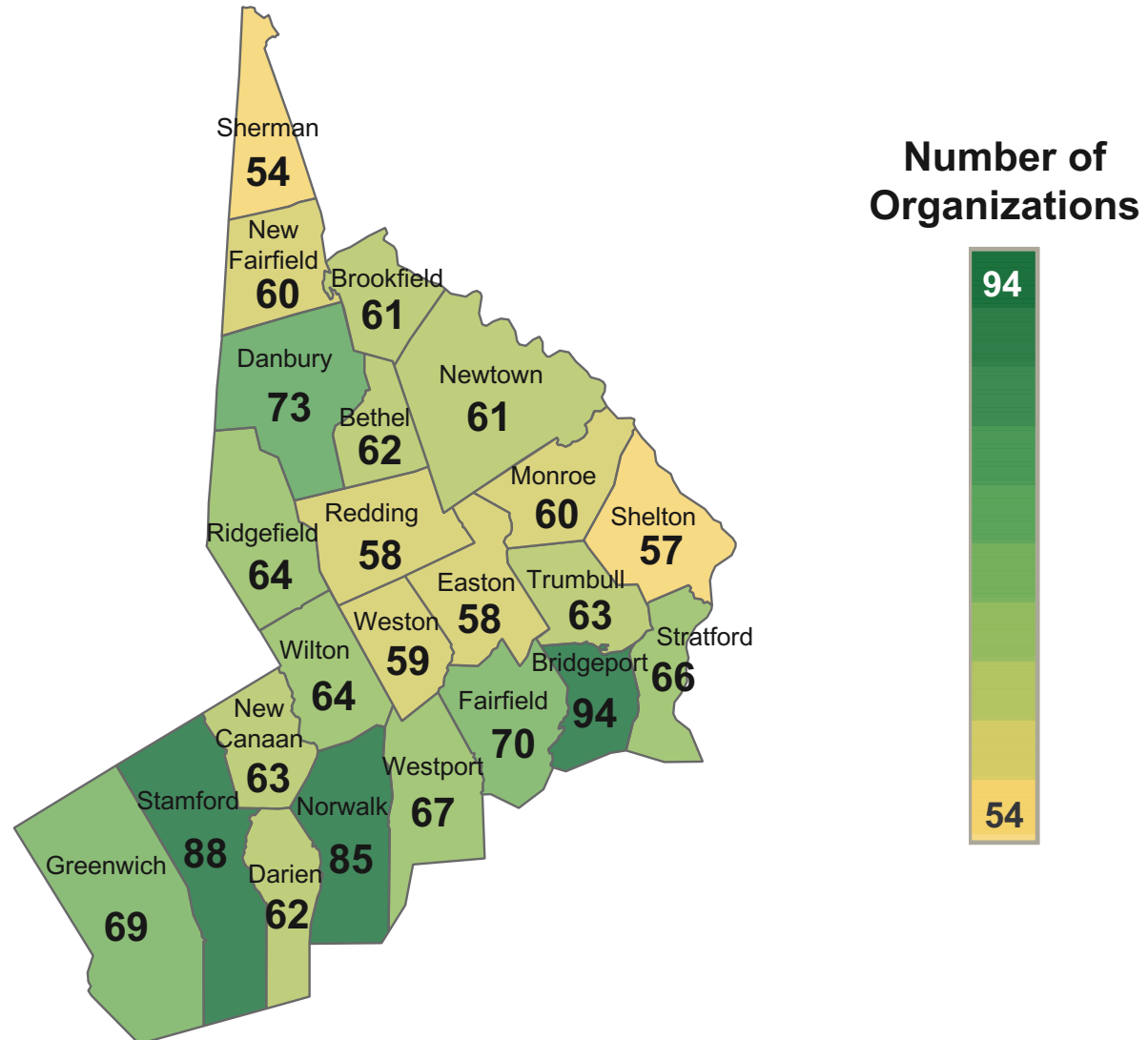

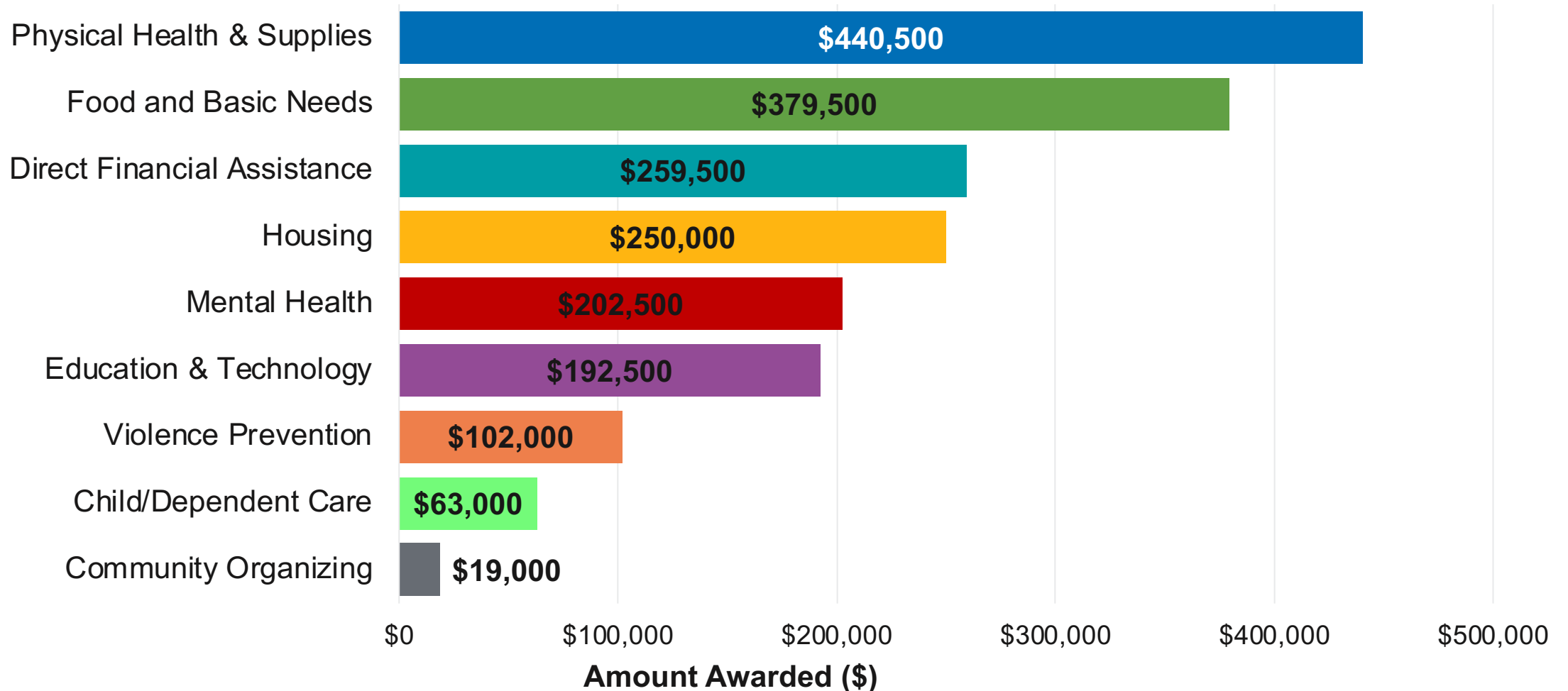
# Geographic Reach of COVID-19 Resiliency Fund Grantees

22 agencies also serve other towns outside the County.



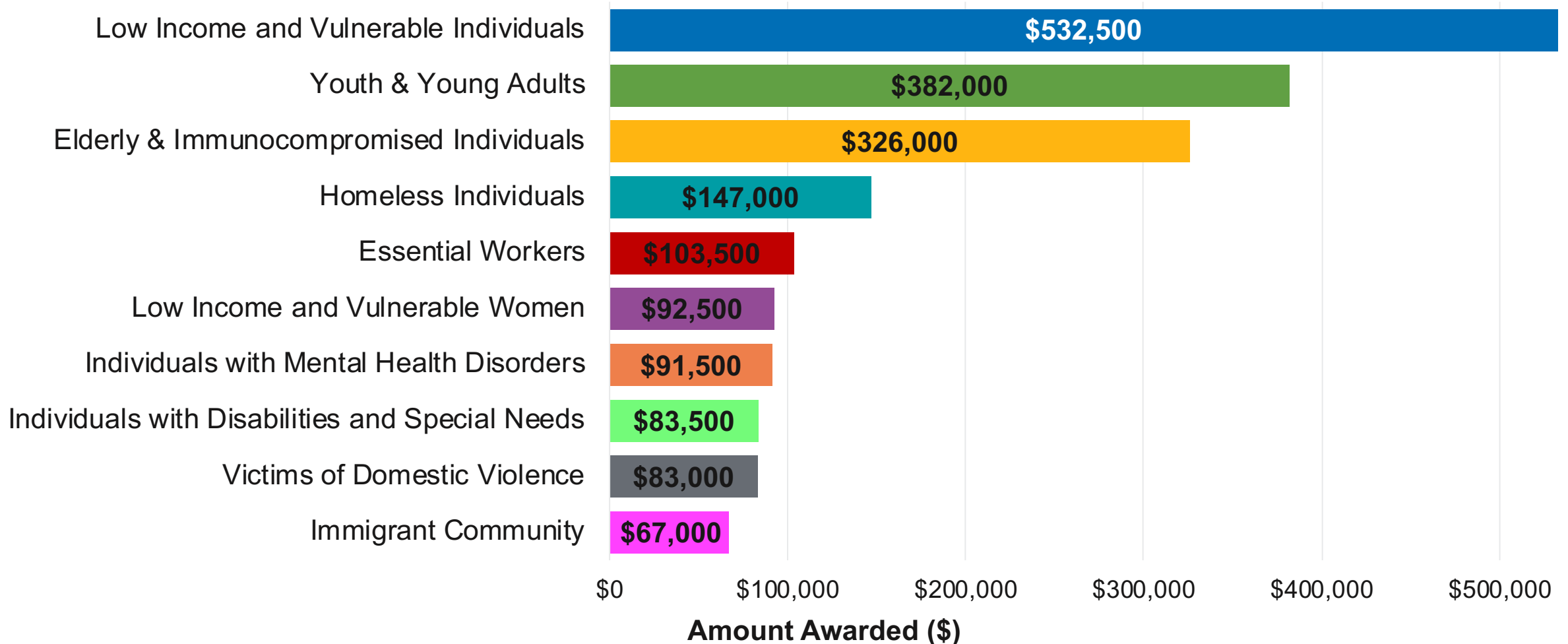
# COVID-19 Resiliency Fund Investment by Program Intervention
